
## **Jumping Frogs**

## for Frog Jumping Day on May 13


## What you'll needed:


 $3^{\prime\prime}\times5^{\prime\prime}$  piece of cardstock in any frog color or a precut  $3^{\prime\prime}\times5^{\prime\prime}$  index card

Google eyes, 1/4" adhesive dots, or marker for eyes





1 Fold the top corner over so touches the other side, press and unfold.






Turn the paper over and fold down where the two folds you just folded meet and unfold.






5 Fold on the dotted lines to start making the frog's body. It should look like 6b.







7 Now fold the bottom of the body up and even with the top point.






Here comes the tricky part. Turn the paper back over and push in at A and B so it looks like figure 4b.






Pull the C corner up to the D corner and press the fold to make one of the frog's front leas. Do the other side in the

front legs. Do the other side in the same way to make the other leg.





For the last fold you need to fold what used to be the bottom down to what is now the bottom. Add some eyes and you're done.

Congratulations, it's a frog!

To make the frog jump put it down and press lightly on its back.
