Now is the time to download the Libby App to continue accessing the same electronic items you've been enjoying on OverDrive.

Features unique to Libby include: A central Shelf: Loans and holds from all your libraries are automatically added to

your Shelf. Also, you won't lose any of your holds or loans when you switch from the OverDrive App to Libby.

Improvements to navigating book series: Easily find the next book in a series from search results, title details, and your Shelf. Libby makes it easier than ever to discover books in a series. Unlimited tags: Create custom tags to categorize books however you'd like, and use Libby's smart tags to track what you've borrowed or get notified about new issues of your favorite magazines.

More notification options: Get push notifications on your mobile device (or emails from libbyapp.com) for available holds, expiring loans, and more. New to apps? Call any Peoria Public Library location and set up a one-on-one tech help appointment.
